# The Whisper Of Schizophrenia: Machine Learning Finds 'Sound' Words Predict Psychosis

Their results show that automated analysis of the two language variables — more frequent use of words associated with sound and speaking with low semantic density, or vagueness — can predict whether an at-risk person will later develop psychosis with 93 percent accuracy.

### One-third of nursing homes cannot meet behavioral health needs

Despite new rules calling for multidisciplinary care teams and more social work involvement in everyday care, 30% of homes reported having inadequate coordination of care between nursing home and community providers. In addition, more than 26% had inadequate infrastructure to handle referrals and transportation, researchers reported in the Journal of the American Geriatric Society.
