"We help with that coordination of care," Parker said. "When people come in, we help identify what their needs are and help connect them to services, whether it's something we can provide or whether they need to go somewhere else in the community." For those in crisis, the next step could be going to the Treatment and Recovery Center (TRC), scheduled to open in 2022. The TRC is located across the street to the north of the **Bert Nash Center**.
